## **Trailblazer Broadband Overview**

- Trailblazer is the Town of Estes Park's Community Owned, local high speed 1 Gig internet service.
- It is the ONLY "fiber to the premise" service in the area
- Our value proposition is clear...

## **Trailblazer Construction Process**

- The overall design of our fiber system follows our electrical lines overhead and underground
- To run all the fiber throughout the valley is a 3-5 year overall buildout in 4 phases; Phase 1 is underway.
- Our fiber construction plan is segmented into smaller sections known as cabinet areas
  - There are 55 of these areas throughout the system, each serving approximately 250 customers
  - Each cabinet area is fed by larger feeds from main hubs
- Service availability is dependent on the following steps:
  - Infrastructure buildout
  - Main fiber installation
  - Splicing and testing the fiber

## Timing:

#### October 2020 - Memorial Day 2021

## **Objectives:**

- 1. Bring Trailblazer Broadband to downtown businesses as quickly as possible
- 2. Minimize disruption and inconvenience to businesses and visitors
- 3. Return all areas to a previous or better condition
- 4. Provide clear communication and transparency throughout the process

**Begin offering service to downtown businesses in 2021** 





## **Careful Planning**

- Careful, cautious review of various options for the path of construction
- Begin with underground work because it is more time and labor intensive
- Complete underground construction during the off season
- Begin on the South side of Elkhorn Ave., which is mostly underground
- Work on the Riverwalk side to eliminate CDOT lane closures and greater business disruption
- Continue to North side of Elkhorn with less invasive overhead construction in the Winter/Spring of 2021





## **Minimal Business Impact**

# We are committed to working quickly with the least possible disruption by:

- Beginning construction after the height of the season has passed
- Completing underground construction in the off season
- Ensuring that each business main entry is accessible at all times
- Limiting sidewalk closures to weekdays only with directional signs will indicate alternative points of access
- Suspending work as early as possible each Friday (by end of the day, Time TBD-ideally by noon)
- Fully restoring each section prior to moving to the next section







## **Project Scope of Work**

- The project is broken out into Phases, each with several sections, to minimize direct impact on any one location to approximately 1 week.
- Working in small sections of approximately 250 feet so there is minimal disruption
- Trench as much as possible on the river side of the Riverwalk
- Pavers will be labeled and replaced in their original location
- Upon completion, there will be a smooth walking surface
- Return each section to its previous condition before moving on to the next section.





## **Project Timeline**

#### Early Oct 2020 - End of Dec 2020

- Construction of South Side of Elkhorn Ave.
- Overall 10 to 12 weeks
- 3 Phases

#### Winter - Spring 2021

- Construction of North Side of Elkhorn Ave.
- As well as Stanley Village area
- Infrastructure completed by Memorial Day 2021

#### Service Available in 2021





## **Phase 1 Construction**

South Side of Elkhorn Ave. Construction

- Location:
  - South of Elkhorn Ave. from Hwy 36 (Kind Coffee) to Riverside (Casa Grande Mexican Restaurant)
- Timing:
  - Late September to late October 2020
- Construction Plan:
  - 4 Sections 1 week each
    - Section 1-Kind Coffee to Stix & Stones
    - Section 2-Mary Jane's to Brownfields
    - Section 3-Brownfield's to Coldwell Banker
    - Section 4-Coldwell Banker to Riverside
- Contingencies:
  - Weather dependent schedule

- Location:
  - Riverside to Moraine
- Approximate Timing:
  - Through the month of November 2020
- Construction Plan:
  - Divided into 3 Sections
- Contingencies:
  - Weather dependent schedule

## **Phase 3 Construction**

#### • Location:

 Moraine to Grandpa's/Highland store (Far west end of the Wiest Parking Lot)

#### • Approximate Timing:

• Mid November through end of 2020

#### • Construction Plan:

- Sections to be determined
- Contingencies:
  - Weather dependent schedule

## North Side of Elkhorn Ave. Construction

- Location:
  - North side of Elkhorn Ave.
- Approximate Timing:
  - North side construction will be concurrent with South side and completed by Memorial Day of 2021
- Construction Plan:
  - All overhead following power lines
- Contingencies:
  - Weather dependent schedule
